Although DEBRA Operates Internationally HELP was able to ensure that the donation will be used to specifically benefit children and families in the Murcia Region.



Below is a short insight into the condition

Children are born with this condition and what should be a happy time for parents becomes a moment of fear and loneliness.

Any Butterfly child needs a great amount of daily care because their skin is as delicate as a butterfly wing and gets wounded at the slightest touch. The parents themselves will find they are responsible for the daily care of the wounds and they can feel very alone and isolated when carrying out this task as they are fearful of hurting their child during the daily bandage changing routines.

In order to try to alleviate the stress the family is confronted with, as soon as the baby is born, a psychologist, a social worker and 2 nurses from DEBRA Charity assist and support the families in every aspect of the child's life.

All the support given to families and carers is funded through fundraising events, charity shops and donations with only 5% government funding.

HUGO'S HOME FARM (Rescue Centre and Petting Corner)



Over the past 12 months HELP has donated 700 euros to the Farm, a part of this to help the construction of a new stable block on a parcel of land adjacent to the existing site. Once the block has been completed HELP will have a plaque on one of the stable walls.

Short history about Hugo's Home Farm

Hugo's Home Farm has primarily been set up as a rescue centre by Helping Coco Horse Rescue, a registered charity here in Spain The mission is to rescue abused, neglected or abandoned equines in the Alicante/Murcia area.

They have a license for up to 9 equines. The animals are rescued, rehabilitated and put onto a rehoming program in the UK. With limited number of spaces, rehoming is paramount for the success of this centre. The new stable block will help enormously with this.

Colin the founder of the charity, has set up the centre and added a few more animals along the way. If you visit you may come across chickens, ducks, love birds, peacocks, micro pigs, pygmy goats, alpacas, donkeys, ponies and of course horses.

With the ongoing costs and day to day running the centre (care for equines, vet and farrier bills, UK transport fees)

it was decided to add the other animals to create a small petting corner for younger visitors plus the chance to walk the alpacas.

After the experience witnessed by these parents, who knew the problem very well, they saw the need to join forces and try and cover neglected and forgotten aspects in the lives of children and adolescents with cancer and their families in the Region of Murcia. Their mission is to improve the quality of life of those children and adolescents affected by cancer and their families, through educational, psychosocial and leisure care, support and accompaniment. They also hope to raise awareness within society.

They are a non – profit making association.

Further good causes

We have also been able to support:The Little Sister's of the Poor (Old People's Home in Cartagena)
The Sucina Orphanage / Pregnancy Centre.

S.O.S. Animals.

In conjunction with Yo Encuentro we helped a Ukrainian family in dire need of help.
